

Competition	Andy Tysoe Shield
Format	Mixed 4 Bowl Singles Knockout Tournament
Shots/Ends	21 Shots or 1 hour duration. The bell will sound for the start of the game once the jack has been set and again after 55 minutes at which point the Jack must have been legally cast for that end to be played. The marker's decision on this shall be final. If the game finishes in a tie, then an extra end shall be played. The marker will toss for Jack.
Dress Code	White tops (or branded bowls tops) above the waist and Greys below for all rounds.
Marker required	The Competitions Committee will organise markers for the first session. The losers in each session will mark the following session.
Umpire	Umpires will be appointed for the tournament
Rink Choice	Determined by Competitions Committee. Rink choices in subsequent rounds will ensure no player has an advantage over their opponent
Starting the game	Players must be ready to start at the appointed time. Choice of the Jack on the first end shall be decided by the toss of a coin, opponent calls
Trial ends	None – all shots count
Dead end	All dead ends shall be an end won by the non-offending player who will be awarded 2 shots and have choice of jack on the next end.
Tied end	Counts as an end and score marked as 0 for both players
Visiting the head	Players may only visit the head after playing their third bowl.
Leaving the green	If a player leaves the green without agreement the game shall be awarded to their opponent. Any exceptional circumstances to leave the green must be agreed with the opponent and Tournament Official. Additional time shall be recorded and added.
Slow play	As a timed game, play should continue in a timely manner. Possession of the rink rules shall be followed, so any player ready to bowl shall not be impeded by any opposing player.

Scorecard	Signed by both players and handed to tournament organiser by marker
Recording of result	Tournament organiser will record the scores and update the tournament sheets
Competition Draw	Standard knockout drawn by Competitions Committee. Preliminary rounds may be required to be played prior to the competition day, at a date and time set by the Competitions Committee.
